All things Covid...

Another school year and another set of Covid rules!

Full information can be found in the flowchart sent by email to you today. However, in short:

- Children under 18 do not need to self isolate if they have been in contact with a positive Covid case (even if that person lives with them). They just need to get a PCR test to be on the safe side. They can come to school as normal (unless PCR result comes back positive)
- Children who show Covid symptoms (cough, high temperature, loss of taste/ smell) must <u>self isolate</u> and get a PCR test. They must stay home until the test result comes through
- The school will send home any children that display Covid symptoms here at school and will not be able to return until a negative PCR test comes through
 - If several children in school test positive for Covid, Miss Matthews will contact the authorities and may look to reintroduce some measures such as mask wearing, cancelling events etc. Should this be required, this will be communicated with all families concerned.
