PE Updates from Mr Gould



Welcome back everyone! So that our PE lessons start with a bang this year, could I please remind children and their families of the following:

- Earrings are not permitted to be worn during PE lessons. We do not allow taping as an alternative at WPS due to risk of injury. Please ensure children either know how to remove them before the lesson, or take them out at home. Thank you!
- On days when the children have PE, they should come to school in their trainers (PE ready). However...if as a family, you feel that your child may get their trainers very dirty at playtime(!), please feel free to also send in their 'outdoor shoes' to change into.
- PE kits should be worn to school on PE days. This includes navy tracksuit bottoms and a school hoodie/jumper on those days when it is a colder (which, is likely most days from now on!).
 Please ensure that regulation PE kits are worn. Contact your class teachers if you are not sure what days PE is on for your child. Thank you!
