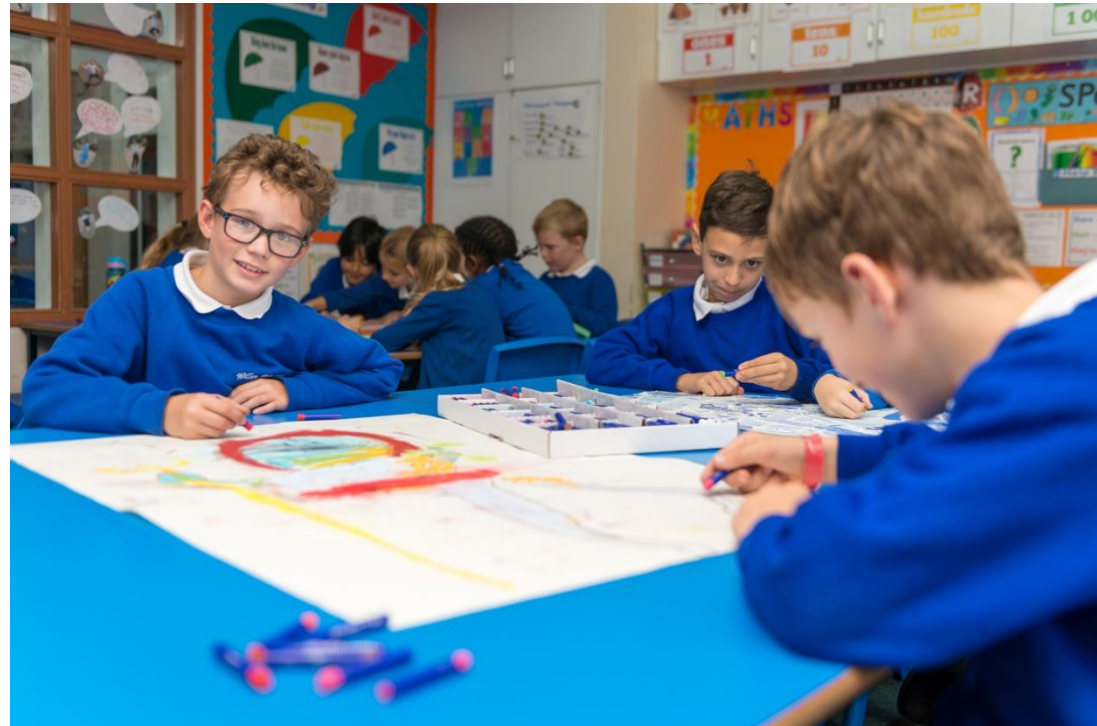

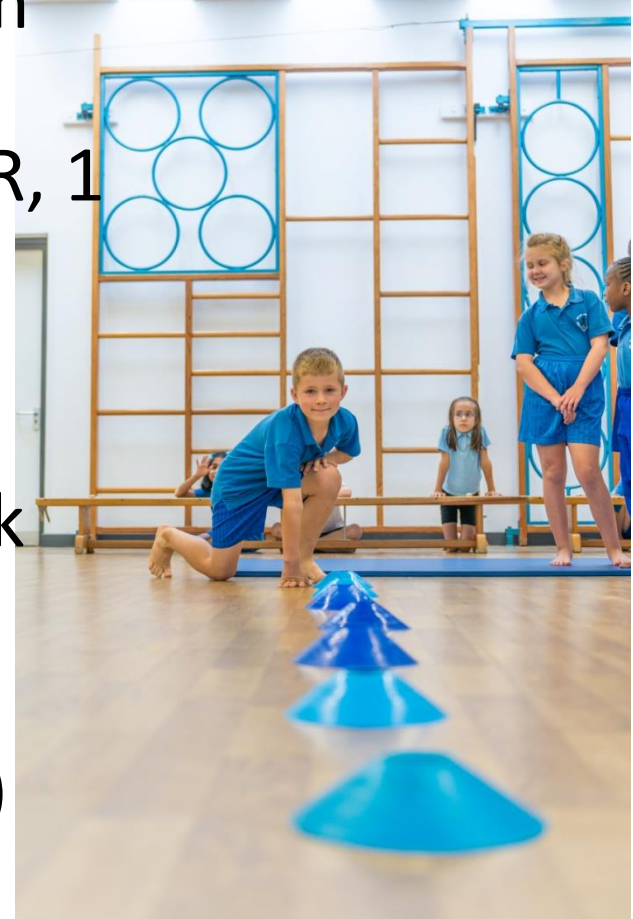

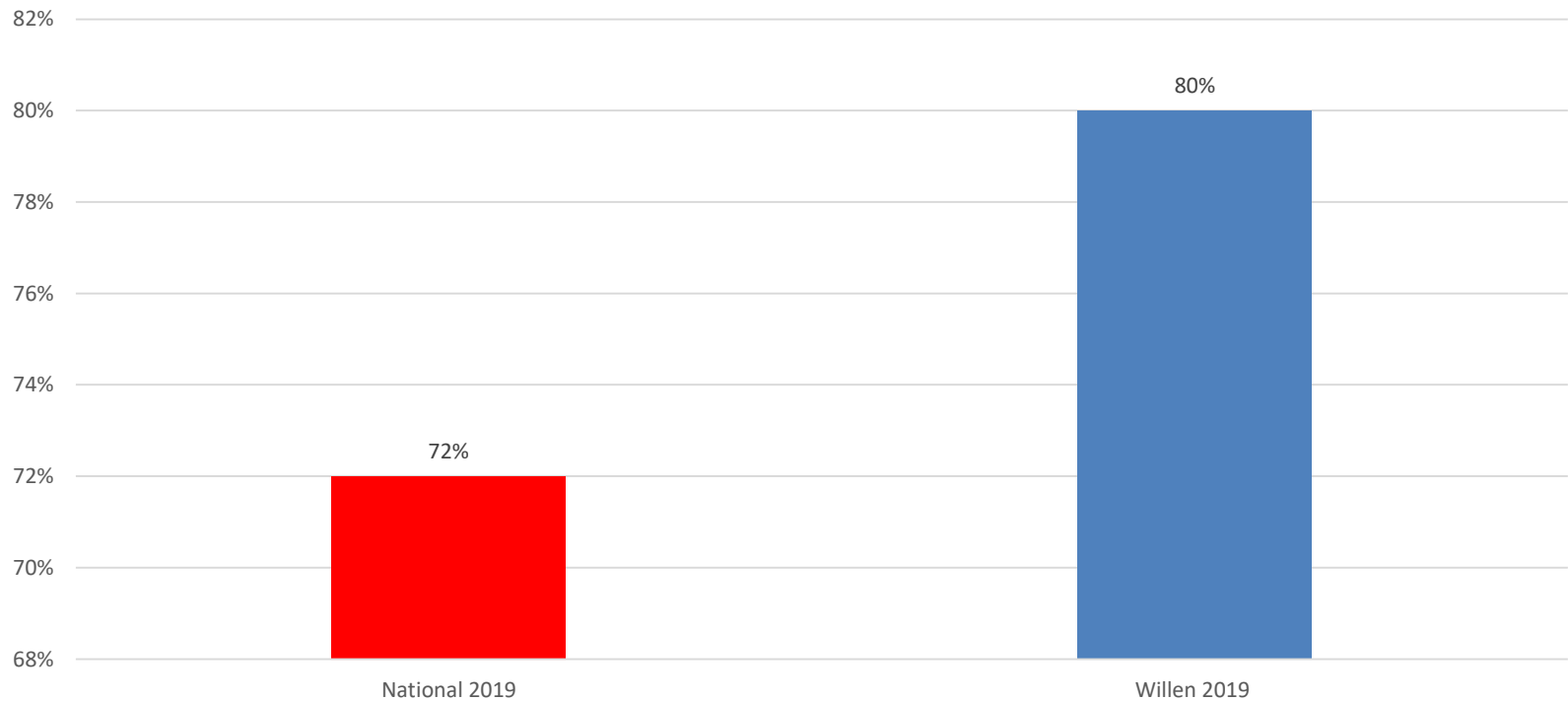




EYFS Results 2019



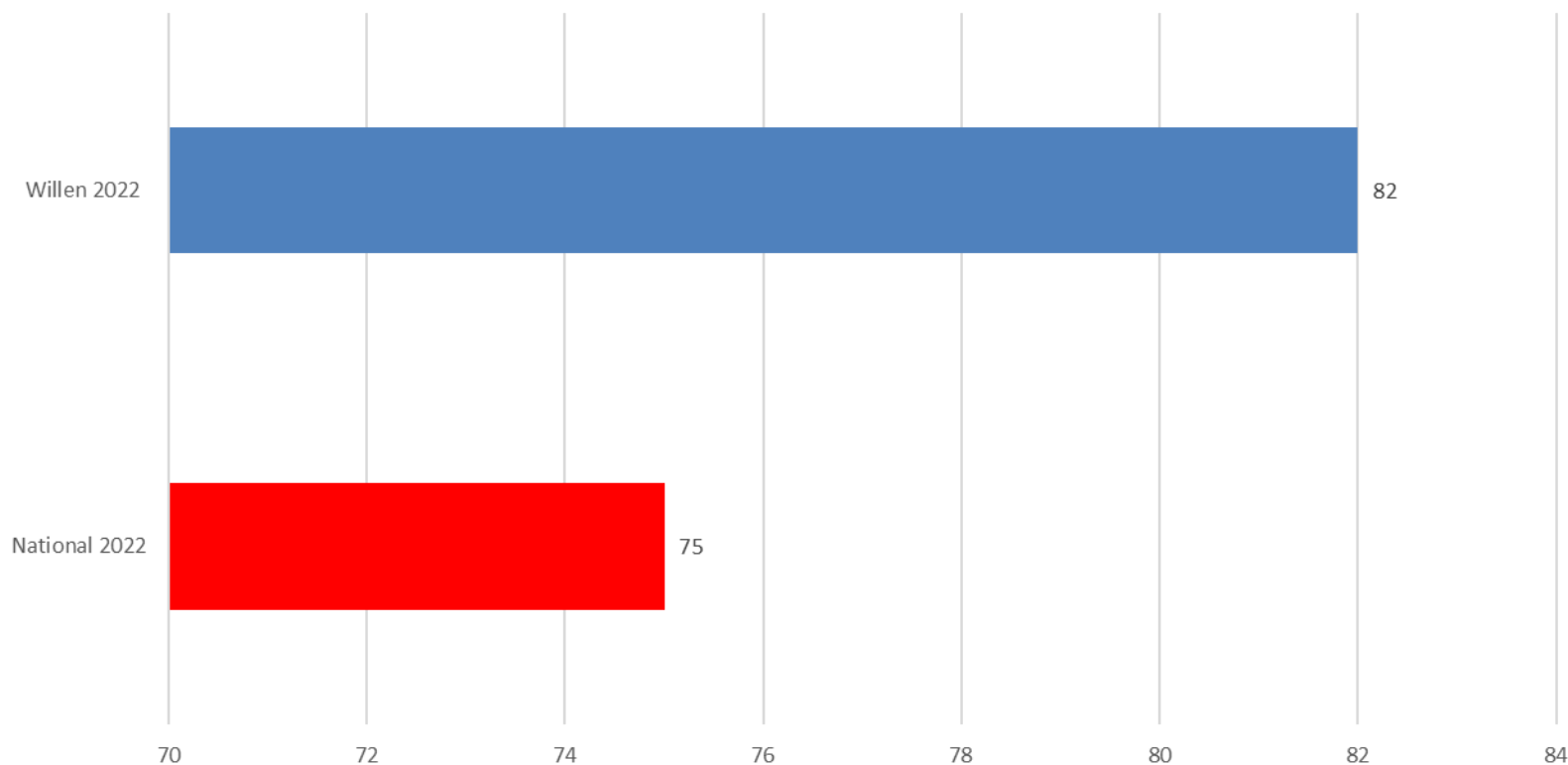
Early Years Outcomes (GLD) 2019

- Children start...FULL TIME approx. 1 week after main school
- Homework – yes, optional
- Trips, visitors and events
- Staff – 2 teachers, 1-2 LSAs
- More able and support provision
- Less able and SEND support and provision
- Access to water and fruit
- Fully equipped outside area, all weather
- Uniform- as rest of school
- Balance; formal learning and experiential learning
- Class Dojo- home/school partnership
- Transition events and parent meetings- June, July and September
